I. CALL TO ORDER

The regular meeting of the Trustees of Terry School District #5 was called to order at 7:02 p.m. by Chairman Cindy Tusler with members Brock Tibbetts, Kathy Meidinger, Laura Fuhrman, and Tyson Browning present.

Also in attendance were Supt. Angela Williams, Clerk Cathy Kalmback, Meriah Smith, Paula Rein, Elizabeth Smith, Michael Peck, and Lizzy Robertson.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

II. CONSENT AGENDA

Kathy Meidinger made a motion to accept the consent agenda. Second by Laura Fuhrman. Motion carried 5-0.

III. PUBLIC COMMENT

Michael Peck stated he had public comment. Board Chairman Cindy Tusler stated if the matter involved staff, one must follow the Uniform Complaint Procedure outlined in Policy #1700. He confirmed he had a complaint about a staff member, and that it was his right to comment during this time. Ms. Tusler said that would be inappropriate. He then left the meeting.

IV. TEACHER'S CORNER

A. Ms. Paula Rein gave a report on her classes. After teaching English & Literature for many years, so is teaching History and Current Events, and will incorporate Creative Writing during the 2nd Semester. Her goal is to instill in the students a love of history.

V. BOARD POLICY

- A. Kathy Meidinger made a motion to approve the 1st and final reading of the following policies as submitted by MTSBA: #'s 1112, 1113, 1425, 1512, 1700, 2100, 2160, 2167, 2168, 3110, 3125, 3225, 4301, 4315, 4340, 4410, 5012, 5223, 5256, 8225, and 8425. Second by Brock Tibbetts. Motion carried 5-0.
- B. Kathy Meidinger made a motion to approve the 1st and final reading of the following recommended revisions and policies from MTSBA: 1610, 2410P, 1512F, 2600, 2600P, and 5120P with Opt 2 to process candidates and Opt 2 we don't disseminate background results. Second by Brock Tibbetts. Motion carried 5-0.
- C. Laura Fuhrman made a motion to accept the 1st and final reading of a new required policy #8425P as submitted from MTSBA. Second by Kathy Meidinger. Motion carried 5-0.

VI. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Strategic Planning: nothing new to report. Still waiting to hear back from Debra Silk.
- B. After discussion regarding options to lower the levy amount by committing oil and gas money to the over base in the General Fund, Kathy Meidinger made a motion to set the General Fund levy at \$31,160.19 which is approximately 5.91 mills for the purpose of maintenance and operation of the district for the 2019-2020 year. Passage of this proposal will increase the taxes on a home with a market value of \$100,000 by approximately \$7.98 and on a home with a market value of \$200,000 by approximately \$15.96. The durational limit of the levy is permanent once approved by voters, assuming the district levies that amount at least once in the next five years. This is with a commitment of \$10,000 of oil and gas money in the over-base budget. Second by Tyson Browning. Motion carried 5-0.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- A. The calendar committee submitted two (2) school calendars for the 19-20 year. After discussion, a 3rd calendar was made. Tyson Browning made a motion to approve Calendar Option #3 as attached to the original minutes. Second by Kathy Meidinger. Motion carried 5-0.
- B. Upon the recommendation of Ms. Angela Williams, Kathy Meidinger made a motion to renew all tenured teachers for the 19-20 school year. Second by Brock Tibbetts. Motion carried 5-0.

- C. Upon the recommendation of Ms. Angela Williams, Brock Tibbetts made a motion to renew all non-tenured teachers for the 19-20 school year. Second by Tyson Browning. Motion carried 5-0.
- D. After discussion, Tyson Browning made a motion to call for a Resolution of Intent to Impose an Increase in Levies, as follows. Second by Kathy Meidinger. Motion carried 5-0.

As an essential part of its budgeting process, the Terry Board of Trustees is authorized by law to impose levies to support its budget. The Terry Board of Trustees <u>estimates</u> the following increases/decreases in revenues and mills for the funds noted below for the next school fiscal year beginning July 1, 2019, using certified taxable valuations from the current school fiscal year as provided to the district:

REGARDING THE BUILDING RESERVE LEVY referenced above, the following are school facility maintenance projects <u>anticipated</u> to be completed at this time:

- 1. Roofs (all 3 buildings)
- 2. Entry Doors
- 3. Boilers

NOTE: This notice is a requirement of SB #307. These are the best estimates of the District as of March 18, 2019. It is impossible to determine exact numbers prior to the end of the fiscal year, so again the above numbers are only ESTIMATES. The Building Reserve Fund levy was new in SB307 in 2017, and the State is anticipating contributing to this fund in the next biennium.

VIII. SUPERINTENDENT'S UPDATE

The end of the 3rd quarter is the 19th. Things are busy around here with the usual end of year happenings. We are completing CRT-Science testing right now and then will begin with Smarter Balanced. We celebrated the end of "I Love to Read" month with Dr. Seuss Day. I think everyone had a good time.

Our students did well in the Academic Olympics in Miles City, and we are awaiting the results from the MCTM (Math) competition that was in Baker. FFA State was cancelled due to the bad weather and road conditions. We're waiting to see when that will be rescheduled. FCCLA State Convention is coming up in Bozeman. We also have 3-6th graders taking their projects to the Science Fair in Billings. High School track has begun. JH track begins April 1st. Now we just need the snow to melt!

Board Policy- We received the new updates from MTSBA through our Policy Maintenance program that we are a part of. There are a lot of them, but as you can see most of them are required revisions. These can be approved on just one reading.

Calendar- The committee met and came up with 2 options for the calendar. The difference in them is whether we come back to school on January 2nd or go after Memorial Day. There isn't a lot of flexibility.

Other things I'm working on are:

REAP grant, CRDC(Civil Rights Data Collection), 21st Century grant application, Private/Non-Public Schools notification, schedule for next year, teacher interviews, budget numbers, CTE spring data collection, etc..

Preschool screening is on the 28th. We will be working with the cooperative as part of our required Child Find. Prom is on the 30th.
